Design a 5, 6 or 7-panel comic strip showing either:

how a Greek god would deal with a modern-day event

OR

illustrating one of the myths we read:

Eos and Tithonius

Orion

Daphne and Apollo

Callisto and Arcus

Ceres and Proserpina

Grades will be based on neatness, colorfulness, using all the panels, using most of the space in the panels (limited white space), quality interpretation/illustration of the chosen myth OR logical resolution to the modern-day event and originality if creating your own myth. If you are creating your own myth make sure that the qualities of the god/goddess you use are shown in your comic. For example, if Eros is in your comic, it should deal with love; if you have Poseidon in your comic, he should be in charge of water. Also, make sure you have a clear problem and resolution to the problem.

You will also need to present your comic.
